Translink Travel Challenge

This year our school is participating in the Translink Eco-Schools Travel Challenge being run in partnership by Keep Northern Ireland Beautiful Eco-Schools and Translink. All children will be asked to take part in this challenge over a 2 week period starting on Monday 5th June 23. A tally sheet will be sent with home your child on Friday 2nd June.

We will look at what transport pupils currently use to get to and from school, and at time spent enjoying the great outdoors (by walking, scooting or cycling) and ask that you and your child try and make sustainable improvements during this period and beyond.

This is a fantastic opportunity for our school to work towards becoming more environmentally sustainable by reducing carbon emissions caused by traffic and is a positive step towards reducing car congestion around the school. It is also a healthy and sociable option for our pupils.
