Dear Parents and Carers

We hope that you and your child have enjoyed your first month at Nursery! The children are now well settled into Nursery and making good progress with the classroom rules and routines. They are also enjoying staying for lunch at the Knockbreda Nursery School Restaurant!

This month, school will share information regarding your child's settling in period. Your Class Teacher will prepare a short settling in report and your child's Learning Journey so far which will be given at the parent - teacher meeting on either Monday 17th, Tuesday 18th or Wednesday 19th of October 2022. In order to facilitate these meetings, school will close at 11.00am on each of these dates. If you would prefer to have this meeting over the phone please let us know. These invites will be sent home on Friday 7th October 2022.

Themes and topics

During these first few weeks of Nursery we will be enhancing the curriculum by observing what is happening in nature. Over the following weeks we will be investigating;

Owls

Apples/ Mushrooms

Spiders

Pumpkins

We will also be responding to the children's interests and ideas on what they would like to learn about.

Forest School

This month we will be starting our Forest School days each week. In our Forest School the children have the freedom to explore using all of their senses which encourages creative, diverse and imaginative play.

These sessions will happen whatever the weather so please ensure your child is dressed appropriately so that they will be comfortable and warm playing outside all day. We would suggest that the girls do not wear dresses and tights on Forest School days, but wear thicker

jogging style bottoms and it is also advisable for all children to wear an additional underlayer and warm socks.

Red Apples will attend each Tuesday for Term 1 beginning on Tuesday 11th October 2022.

Green Apples will attend each Wednesday for Term 1 beginning on Wednesday 12th October 2022.

The benefits of Forest Schools for children and society are well-documented:

- 1. Increased confidence and independence of the child.
- 2. Development of their language skills by providing a real context for language.
- 3. Ability to take risks and to become more open to new experiences.
- 4. The forest school program evolves from the needs of the child and includes the child's interests.
- 5. Provides the practitioner with an alternative view of the child and further insights into a child's development.
- 6. Beneficial to a child's all-round development, particularly in the areas of personal, social and emotional, language and communication.
- 7. Underpins the principles laid down in the foundation stage guidelines.
- 8. Provides opportunities for the children to take risks, problem solve and use thinking skills.
- 9. Complements learning in the classroom and can be transferred.

- For Health and Safety reasons, the Knockbreda Campus operates as a traffic-free zone
 where possible. Parking is not permitted on the campus; please do not park on the
 double yellow lines opposite Nursery's top gate or in the staff car parking spaces.

• Online Payment System

Our online payment system SchoolMoney is now live and available to use. Everyone should have received their Welcome Message and log-in details by text and email. If you have not received these, please contact Mrs Benson. School fund and school meals should be paid for online with no need for using cash or cheques in school. We hope that going forward you will find this a convenient way to make payments to school.

School Lunches

Please note that school lunches should be paid for online using the SchoolMoney system. These should be paid for by 9.00am each Monday and we would appreciate

your support with timely payments. The weekly cost is £12.50 at present. If your child is unable to have a school meal that has already been paid for, the balance will be carried over to the following week's account.

Daily School Hours:

Drop off: flexible drop off between 8.30am-8.45am

Pick up: flexible pick up between 12.45pm-1pm

Once your child has been dropped off / collected, we would ask that you exit the school building straight away and do not congregate in the main reception area to help alleviate congestion at these busy times.

• Health & Safety in school grounds

For their safety, we wish to emphasise the importance of ensuring that children are kept under direct supervision until they enter their classroom in the mornings and once they leave their classroom at pick-up time. Children should also stay off the grass verge at drop off and pick up time and should not be allowed to climb on fences, gates or handrails. Please encourage children to come into school and leave school walking in a calm manner to help prevent accidents and collisions with other children.

One-Way System

Now that children are arriving and leaving school at the same time each day, the entrance and exit gates to school will become increasingly congested. Please continue to follow our one way system of entering through the top main gate and exiting via the bottom side gate – there are signs in place as a reminder. Please advise anyone dropping-off or collecting your child to adhere to this one-way system to minimise congestion at these busy times. (If access in needed for prams /buggies, please continue to use the bottom side gate to enter and exit). Please also note that the school gates will be closed during school hours. If you are entering the school, please ensure you close the gate behind you.
