Dear Parents and Carers

We hope that you and your child have enjoyed your first month at Nursery! The children are now well settled into Nursery and making good progress with the classroom rules and routines. They are also enjoying staying for lunch at the Knockbreda Nursery School Restaurant!

This month, school will share information regarding your child's settling in period. Your Class Teacher will prepare a short settling in report which will be given at the parent - teacher meeting on either Tuesday 17th, Wednesday 18th or Thursday 19th of October 2023. In order to facilitate these meetings, school will close at 11.00am on each of these dates. If you would prefer to have this meeting over the phone please let us know. These invites will be sent home on Friday 6th October 2023.

This week we have started our Special Helpers! This is where three children from each class are chosen to help with routines throughout the week. They will be given a special badge to wear on their uniform all week (please return on Friday). When your child is a special helper they will be observed in a range of situations and these observations will be shared via Seesaw. At the end of the week each child will take home a red bag with a story and puppets in for the weekend. This is to say thank you for all of their hard work over the week. Please return these bags (with everything in them) on Monday morning to your class teacher. We hope you will enjoy looking at a small snapshot of what your child does in a busy week at Knockbreda Nursery School!

Themes and topics

During these first few weeks of Nursery we will be enhancing the curriculum by observing what is happening in nature. Over the following weeks we will be investigating; **Apples**

Spiders

Pumpkins

We will also be responding to the children's interests and ideas on what they would like to learn about.

Halloween Family Evening

You are warmly invited to our family drop-in evening that is taking place between **4.30** – **6.00pm pm Thursday 26**th **October**.

We will have refreshments available to purchase, along with raffle tickets, and temporary tattoos (cash payment only) and there will be free Halloween themed activities. This is an opportunity for an informal visit to your child's classroom and to hear about their favourite things in Knockbreda Nursery School!

Forest School

This month we will be starting our Forest School days each week. In our Forest School the children have the freedom to explore using all of their senses which encourages creative, diverse and imaginative play.

These sessions will happen whatever the weather so please ensure your child is dressed appropriately so that they will be comfortable and warm playing outside all day. We would suggest that the girls do not wear dresses and tights on Forest School days, but wear thicker jogging style bottoms and it is also advisable for all children to wear an additional underlayer and warm socks.

Red Apples will attend each Wednesday for Term 1 beginning on Wednesday 11th October 2023.

Green Apples will attend each Thursday for Term 1 beginning on Thursday 12th October 2023.

The benefits of Forest Schools for children and society are well-documented:

- 1. Increased confidence and independence of the child.
- 2. Development of their language skills by providing a real context for language.
- 3. Ability to take risks and to become more open to new experiences.
- 4. The forest school program evolves from the needs of the child and includes the child's interests.
- 5. Provides the practitioner with an alternative view of the child and further insights into a child's development.
- 6. Beneficial to a child's all-round development, particularly in the areas of personal, social and emotional, language and communication.
- 7. Underpins the principles laid down in the foundation stage guidelines.
- 8. Provides opportunities for the children to take risks, problem solve and use thinking skills.
- 9. Complements learning in the classroom and can be transferred.

Important information

- For Health and Safety reasons, the Knockbreda Campus operates as a traffic-free zone where possible. Parking is not permitted on the campus; please do not park on the double yellow lines opposite Nursery's top gate or in the staff car parking spaces.

School Lunches

Please note that school lunches should be paid for online using the SchoolMoney system. These should be paid for in advance by midnight on Sunday and we would appreciate your support with timely payments. The weekly cost is £12.50 at present. If your child is unable to have a school meal that has already been paid for, the balance will be carried over to the following week's account.

Daily School Hours:

Drop off: flexible drop off between 8.30am-8.40am (Doors re-open at 9.00am for any late arrivals)

Pick up: flexible pick up between 12.45pm-1pm

Once your child has been dropped off / collected we would ask that you exit the school building straight away and do not congregate in the main reception area to help alleviate congestion at these busy times.

• Health & Safety in school grounds

For their safety, we wish to emphasise the importance of ensuring <u>that children are kept under direct supervision until they enter their classroom in the mornings and once they leave their classroom at pick-up time.</u> Children should also stay off the grass verge at drop off and pick up time and should not be allowed to climb on fences, gates or handrails. Please encourage children to come into school and leave school walking in a calm manner to help prevent accidents and collisions with other children.
